

RFQ – Sponsorship Evaluation & Measurement & Related Services Q&A (#1)

- 1. Will our work product, including the model we deliver to NC Lottery, be available via public record? If it is subject to public records laws, is there any way for us to protect against the model becoming public record? For purposes of fulfilling public records request, we will only release the redacted version of the Responding Contractor's Bid. Therefore, Responding Contractors may submit a redacted version of their Bids in addition to their full Bids.**
- 2. Minority Business Participation: The RFQ states that the Potential Contractor should complete and include in its proposal either Affidavits A&B or Affidavit C. If we do not fill out A&B and elect to fill out only C, would we lose out on certain points that may be assigned to us if we elected to subcontract for Minority Business Participation? Certain points will be allocated for the Minority Business Participation category. Responding Contractors may earn up to the maximum points allocated based upon their response in this category.**
